Maintenance Schedule for Normal and Severe Conditions - General Countries

This maintenance schedule outlines the minimum required maintenance that you should perform to ensure the trouble-free operation of the vehicle.

Due to regional and climatic differences, some additional servicing may be required. Please consult the warranty booklet for a more detailed description.

NOTE: The following items must be used for "severe condition" indicated on schedule.

- Engine oil and engine oil filter: A/B/C/D/E
- Transmission fluid: B/D

Severe driving conditions:

- A. Driving less than 8 km (5 miles) per trip or, in freezing temperatures, driving less than 16 km (10 miles) per trip.
- B. Driving in extremely hot over 35 °C (over 95 °F) conditions.
- C. Extensive idling or long periods of stop-and-go driving.
- D. Towing trailer, driving with a loaded roof rack, or driving in mountainous conditions.
- E. Driving on muddy, dusty, or de-iced roads.
